FOR A RESPONSIBLE TRAVEL!

DOCUMENTS In Europe, the annual consumption of paper amounts to 90 million tons. In Swiss, an resident consumes 194 kilos of paper per year.



ENCOURAGE SOFT MOBILITY

A TGV consumes 115 times less C02 than a plane (80.7 kg of C02 per passenger). The plane is 80 times more polluting than the train.

According to a study conducted by the IPCC, in 2021, 81% of travelers surveyed said they plan to choose a sustainable accommodation option in the coming year.
